CHECK IN

REGISTRATION

Friday, June 4 registration opens at 4 PM. Please do not arrive before this time to avoid traffic congestion at the Capitol. Use State Street entrance and follow signs to registration area. Registration area is located at East door of the Judicial wing.

Saturday, June 5 all arrivals must check-in at the registration area when they arrive in order to participate in events and meals.

Only one adult should come into the registration area with the following documentation:

- Final Unit roster
- Check for additional payment if needed
- Medical Forms
- Permission slips (if needed)

Units will receive registration packet with:

- Campsite zone location assignment
- Map of capitol grounds
- Schedule of events
- Emergency contact information
- Participant wristbands (for security and meals all participants are required to wear a wristband for the weekend)
- Pre-ordered participant patches
- Name of Unit Commissioner

CHECK OUT

- Units must make arrangements for early check-out when registering
- Campsite inspection and approval by your Unit Commissioner or Zone Staff
- Units pick up health forms at your First Aid Site
- Units conduct a head count and account for all of your Scouts and adults
