Each Camping Zone has:

- Campsites
- Food tent
- First Aid site
- Latrines
- Water Buffalo



JAMBOREE STYLE CAMPING IN CAMPING ZONE

- No canopies or excess camping equipment
- Be prepared to carry tents and equipment to your assigned campsite
- NO FLAMES including campfires, lanterns or stoves
- NO vehicles permitted in campsites
- NO trenching (ditching) of tents
- NO RV camping – contact local campgrounds

PACK/TROOP/CREW EQUIPMENT

Suggested common camping equipment (this is not a complete list)

- Tents
- American/Pack/Troop/Crew/Patrol/Den Flags
- Unit First Aid Kits
- Drinking Water
- Camp Chairs (Not permitted at stage show)
- Garbage Bags (LEAVE NO TRACE)
- GPS navigation hand-held unit if you have one

PERSONAL EQUIPMENT

Suggested personal camping equipment (this is not a complete list)

- Scout Uniform
- Scout Handbook
- Notebook/Pencils/Pens
- Flashlight
- Sleeping Bag/Blankets/Pillows/Ground Cloth
- Appropriate Outerwear/Rain Gear
- Hand Sanitizer
- Spending Money
- Camera
- Toiletries (Toothbrush, toothpaste, etc)
- Watch/Alarm Clock
